PROJECT 25- 41 updated 8/12/2025	<i>PHILIPPINES, Luzon Island (Aeta People group)</i> “KEITH’S CHAPEL” in Santo Nino village pastor Ronald DeVera with our partner network “Church in the Mountains”
LOCATION	The 200 villages of the Aeta people group lie on the slopes of Mt Pinatubo volcano, on Luzon island – about 50 miles northwest of Manila.
FUNDING:	This project includes the chapel AND a simple pastor house -- The total budget is \$ 10,462 (includes materials, labor, transport, etc) So far we have \$ 4,086 raised. We are ¼ of the way to the goal!
STATUS:	The Net Need to complete both parts is... \$ 6,376

Pastor Ronald De Vera is a Christian pastor who ministers in “Santo Nino” village, and area near the city of Bamban, in Tarlac province. Their temporary shelter is only made of wood and sawali and since their members are getting more and more numerous, he is requesting to have a concrete church in his ministry area. He also needs a simple house for his family. SOCI will provide (already funded) a well or spring-tap to water.
